- 9.21. Held a joint autumn conference of the China Research Center and the InAsia Forum (Peace Hall 1F Conference Room)
 - Topic 1: “During the first period of reform and opening up (1978-2012), the core of the country's operation was focused on economic development, and the second period of reform and opening up (as of 2012-2-24) has shifted to prioritizing national security.”
 - Topic 2: “No matter who wins the election, there will be no change in U.S. policy toward China, but rather increased pressure on China,” said Yang Xiangfeng, professor at Yungnam University.
 - Topic 3: Consul General Jung Jae-Nam in Wuhan emphasized that “the Northeast Project is closely related to China's long-term Northeast Policy and the territorial boundary dispute of the reunified country, and that it is important to note the Northeast Project started at a time when North Korea was extremely wary of China.”
 - Topic 4: “Korea is promoting its national image through ODA, and as the country's ODA support is gradually increasing, the government should come up with a plan to harvest relative investment benefits through consortiums with companies.”
 - Presentation of four topics followed by in-depth discussions among experts on Korea-China relations at the seminar
